

"wine literacy can't be taught in three hours"

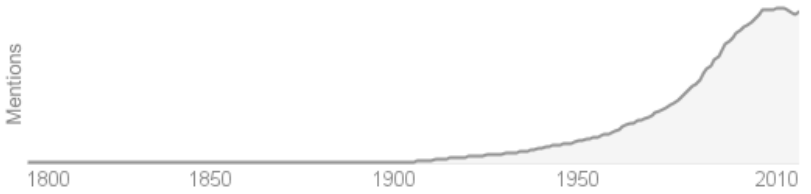
Origin
